CLIMATE CHANGE

- Combating Climate Change
 - Another core priority for U.S. foreign policy, national security
 - A program area where USAID already has extensive equities
- Climate change impacts nearly every sector and country in which USAID works
 - New Agency-wide climate strategy
 - To help focus and improve our efforts to meet this urgent crisis
 - Thinking about Climate in a new and profound way, which we will reflect in the Strategy thanks to an Agency-wide effort to complete it by November 1st.
- Biden's Virtual Leaders Summit on Climate
 - Catalyzing global ambition to address the climate crisis
 - USAID has coordinated closely with the NSC on deliverables for the Summit
 - Great opportunity to highlight our work





COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- Defeating the COVID-19 pandemic
 - One of the highest priorities at home and abroad
 - USAID continues to be at the forefront of this fight around the world
- USAID Contributions
 - o \$4 Billion to Gavi, the vaccine alliance
 - Advancing equitable global access to COVID-19 vaccines
- USAID COVID Task Force
 - PPL's Office of Policy is working closely with the Agency's newly created COVID Task Force to ensure that USAID undertakes a coordinated, Agency-wide approach to this global challenge







STRATEGIC COMPETITION: PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

- Strategic Competition Issues People's Republic of China
 - Beginning to formulate USAID's role in this administration's engagement with Beijing;
 - And the related cross-cutting and nuanced issues



- Where the United States and USAID can cooperate vs. compete with Beijing
 - How we clarify what this means in practice
 - Recognize we operate in a different space than the State Dept. or DoD



Monitoring, Evaluation & Collaborating, Learning & Adapting (CLA) (LER)


- Streamlined planning & reporting

- Office of Learning, Evaluation and Research (or LER)
 - Supports USAID to be an effective learning organization

- Our work falls within three linked mandates:
- **EVIDENCE:** Strengthen Agency capacity to build and use evidence to inform decisions.
 - Evidence Act Implementation: Agency Evaluation Officer, Agency Learning Agenda, Annual
 Evaluation Plan, Evidence Capacity Assessment
 - Support Joint Strategic Plan Development and Manage the Annual Performance Plan and Report
 on JSP objectives
 - Business owner for performance management workstream of the Development Information
 Solution
 - Support for monitoring, evaluation, and learning around COVID-19

 learning and adaptation as part of an integrated Program Cycle
 - Program Monitoring
 - Evaluation
 - Collaborating, Learning and Adapting
- ORGANIZATIONAL LEARNING: Develop guidance and support for improving Knowledge Management and Organizational Learning (KMOL) at USAID
 - Knowledge Retention pilot with Missions
 - KMOL policy
