

Exciting Opportunity to Invest in the Next Generation of Agency Leaders: Mentors Needed for UAA/USAID Mentoring Program

The Cohort 12 Mentoring Program partnered with two USAID bureaus (AFR and GH) and the Senior Leadership Group (SLG), resulting in 38 mentors and 42 mentees. Launching the thirteenth cohort in November/December 2023 will align with Agency leadership priorities for a strengthened senior workforce and UAA's programmatic objective to contribute to developing the current and next generation of Agency leaders. Additional information for Cohort 13 will be available in the next few months. However, the Agency has requested UAA to expand the program.

Alumni have a wealth of knowledge and experience to share with new leaders in the field, regardless of their backstop. Alumni Mentor recruitment efforts will be heightened during August and September to help reach the numbers needed to address the Agency's priority. New interested alumni will be asked to complete an online profile to assist in matching mentees and mentors for Cohort 13. Mentors and mentees will receive orientation and training virtually in January 2024. The Program is demand-driven by mentees.
