## Registration with the USAID Alumni Association

UAA wants to remain engaged with its FSN colleagues, as we continue on our various journeys. The multiple ways we can do this include:

- 1. **UAA website**. The UAA website is <a href="https://www.usaidalumni.org">https://www.usaidalumni.org</a>
  It is fully accessible, without UAA membership or registration. It contains a LOT of information and links related to USAID's dissolution, including the status of legal challenges and job search aids. Links to the June 30 farewell event videos are there. While accessing some information may require clicking through a couple of levels, there is an up-front link with FSN-related information which will be periodically updated.
- 2. UAA Registration. Former FSNs are encouraged to register with UAA (become a Registrant). UAA regularly sends all of its communications to Registrants, and registering will enable UAA to rapidly communicate with you. There is no cost to becoming a Registrant. There is a simple link on the left side of the UAA website homepage to become a Registrant.
- 3. **UAA Membership**. Former FSNs are also encouraged to become a full member of UAA. There is also a link on the left side of the UAA website homepage for membership. Currently, full membership requires payment of a \$1 annual membership fee for USAID alumni who retired or lost their jobs after January 2025. We know that this creates an operational challenge for people overseas, and are working to fix it. We will let you know when that's done.
