 - **Fees:** Uses a sliding fee scale to determine how much an uninsured participant will pay based only on income and family size. Encourages patients without private insurance to apply for Medicaid, DC Healthcare Alliance (health insurance plan for DC residents who DO NOT qualify for Medicaid), and other local county programs in Maryland. Payments and visit costs are adjusted based on the ability to pay.

Mission is to bridge patients who were not previously part of the healthcare system to formal care either at our own clinic or at one of our community partners. We provide medical services for uninsured or underinsured patients free of charge regardless of race, gender, sexual orientation, or documentation status. Has partnerships with other community partners and clinics to provide subspecialty care that is outside the scope of our practice.
